The Katharina Engnell Foundation OFFICIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION

The purpose of the Katharina Engnell Foundation Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to apprentice and pre-apprentice students pursuing a union apprenticeship for the building trades or related education & training at an approved institution in the State of Washington.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must be:
 - Accepted in a union building trades apprenticeship, or
 - Accepted in a recognized pre-apprentice building trades entry program, or
 - Pursuing approved building trades career related education at an approved institution.

2. Granting of a scholarship shall be partially based on an original essay of 500 words or less. Applicants may choose between two topics:
 - 1) How can the union movement reach out to the next generation of workers in this country?
 - 2) How will union membership benefit your life and how will you pass it on and help others?

3. The application must be **postmarked by the last Wednesday of December** to be considered for an award.

4. The Katharina Engnell Foundation Board of Trustees shall make the scholarship selections. Awards are based on three categories: financial need, the student's essay, and student's community involvement & achievement.

5. Payment of the award shall be made directly to the trust or institution administering the applicant's training/education program.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:

- 1) Proof of acceptance in a union apprenticeship, pre-apprenticeship program or other approved program.
- 2) At least one letter of recommendation, preferably from someone involved with the craft or field the student is entering.
- 3) Copies of high school or college transcripts.
- 4) Documentation of community service & involvement by the applicant, with special emphasis on working people's issues & needs.

Once the winners have been selected, recipients will be notified of procedures for disbursement of scholarship funds. Every effort will be made to accommodate the recipient's payment schedule.

The Committee reserves the right review and modify these policies yearly. Any suggestions to improve this application form should be referred to the Katharina Engnell Scholarship Foundation in writing.
