

IMPORTANT EVENT INFO

PLEASE READ:

Due to the current Covid-19 pandemic, some additional rules and regulations will be in place for this event. The Border Terrier Club of America organizers will work with state and local government and public health authorities prior to the start of the show to determine risks and mitigation factors. At this time, these are the advised guidelines. These guidelines may be revised as circumstances dictate.

Final event rules will be listed in the final confirmations.

On Site Process and Procedures are as follows:

The following individuals will not be permitted on the show grounds:

- An individual who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms
- An individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 within last two weeks

An individual who has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks

All Speciality participants will be required to sign a Border Terrier Club of America INC. Health Acknowledgement & Liability Waiver in order to remain at our scheduled events

Full Covid policy and waiver form will be attached at the end of the premium.

- Border Terrier Club of America, Inc. shall require temperature monitoring for volunteers, officials, exhibitors, and service providers once daily prior to entering the event areas. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to enter the event areas
- Everyone entering the show grounds will be required to wear a mask. Signage to this effect will be posted at the entrance and throughout the grounds. This includes when running your dog. The club will not provide masks so please come prepared.
- Please note, judges, club members, trial secretaries and facility staff may remove their masks to eat when in their area away from exhibitors. If this is a problem for you please avoid these areas.
- Walk-thrus will be split into smaller groups.
- Course maps will be posted on site as well as posted on Fast Time's website and will be emailed to exhibitors the night before each trial day at some point AFTER 6pm. Printed maps will NOT be handed out to exhibitors.
- Per AKC, leashes may be carried on your person while running your dog, either in your pocket or looped over your body or tied around your waist. Leashes not carried will be moved with a leash grabber. This grabber will be wiped off every few leashes. If this bothers you, please come prepared to carry your leash.
- Full Covid policy and waiver form attached at the end of the premium.



SPECIAL EVENT AGILITY VETERAN GLORY RUN

Celebrate your agility veteran with an exhibition run over a course primarily of jumps and tunnels. Will be run on either jumpers with weaves or time 2 beat course, or feel free to make up your own course. Run your dog over whatever obstacles you are comfortable with and at whatever jump height, even if that's bars on the ground. This is not a timed event and there are no placements. This event will be run midday.

To be eligible for this event a Border Terrier must be 7 years of age or older, must have earned an agility title other than ACT1 or ACT2, and must not be entered in the agility trial at the specialty.

Each entrant will receive a special commemorative rosette imprinted with the terrier's name and AKC title prefixes/suffixes.

*Emailed or faxed entries will **POSSIBLY** be accepted within the last 48 hours before the trial closes if run limits have not been reached. Please email us for more information and availability, but **do not rely on this method of entry.**

REFUNDS: No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of event organizing committee. No entry will be refunded in the event a dog's entries are withdrawn after the closing date in the event; a dog and/or handler are injured, absent, disqualified, excused from competition by the action of the Trial Committee, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds after closing date for bitches in season only. There is a \$5.00 processing fee for **ANY** written refund checks. **No refunds for overpayments \$10 or less.**

BITCHES IN SEASON:

Bitches in season are not eligible to participate in agility trials. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$5.00 processing fee.

To receive a refund **NOTIFICATION MUST** be given to the trial secretary **PRIOR TO THE START OF JUDGING** on the first day the bitch is entered. Written verification from a veterinarian is also **REQUIRED** & must be RECEIVED with a copy of the dog's final confirmation no later than 48 hours after the end of the trial. **Please scan & email these documents to trialsec@fasttimesagility.com or send them via fax to 888-521-1706.**

ABOUT RETURNED CHECKS

Fast Times will not return checks for entries that are not accepted, or entries cancelled before the check has been deposited. We shred all unused checks.

Remember to double check your entry to be sure the form is complete & payment is correct. Payments can be check, money order or Fast Times Gift Certificates. We Cannot Accept Cash!

Data Entry and Changes to your Information

Data entry mistakes happen. That is why we ask everyone to READ their preliminary confirmation and mailed final confirmation. For the majority of entries, dog and owner/handler information remains the same. However, if you have a:

- New email address
- New Titles
- New Handler
- New address and phone
- New jump height

(including jump height changes from trial to trial. For example, dog jumps 20" at one trial, then 24C" in the next trial.)

Highlighting **ANY** of these changes on entry forms would be especially helpful so that these changes can be updated in our database. Then, please review your confirmations carefully to ensure that your requested changes have been made.

PRIZES

AWARDS & CHALLENGER TROPHIES

AWARDS:

All placements will receive a sun catcher with Specialty artwork

Each terrier that earns one or more qualifying scores will receive one BTCA Specialty logo lapel pin.

CHALLENGE TROPHIES:

The Tate and Sunkist Challenge Trophies are offered through the Border Terrier Club of America, Inc. for competitions at the National Specialty Shows only. To be awarded to the High In Class dogs.

For permanent possession, the trophy must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog or at consecutive shows.

The Tate Trophy, offered by Sally Redding, will be awarded for regular classes in Novice, Open and Excellent/Masters. The Sunkist Trophy, offered by Harriett Haydon, will be awarded for preferred classes Novice, Open and Excellent/Masters. To be eligible the dog must be in the same class for both STD and JWW (so the competing dog must run in Novice for both STD and JWW, Open for both STD and JWW, or Excellent/Masters for both STD and JWW). To qualify for either award, the dog must qualify in both STD and JWW. The scores for both STD and JWW are combined and the highest combined score wins. If there is a tie, the winner will be determined by the highest combined percentage under the standard course time (SCT) the dog ran in STD and JWW (SCT minus dog's time, divided by SCT in STD plus SCT minus dog's time, divided by SCT in JWW).

In the event of a tie, the yards per second will be calculated for each run and averaged. The fastest collective time will win. A rosette and a framed BTCA Specialty Logo print will be awarded at the Awards Dinner to the winners at each level.

TRIAL REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$30.00 will be made for each returned check.

FAX, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as trial closes or limits are reached. Acknowledgment of entries will include confirmation notices.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS—Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

CONSULT FINAL CONFIRMATION FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

WALK-THRUS. No umbrellas allowed during walk-thrus.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

DOGS This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners listing number (**if the trial-giving club is offering the option of Canine Partners entries. See front page of the premium for that information**), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate if the trial-giving club is offering the option of mixed breed entries and provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to Judging, otherwise, they must be available for measuring before their class begins.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2021, For Exhibition Only (FEO) and Fix and Go On (FNG) are permanent parts of the AKC agility program. Below is the updated language.

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FEO runs WILL be allowed at these trials.

RESULTS

Results will be posted on the FAST TIMES website **Emails are sent to all those exhibitors who had a qualifying run. If you had all non-qualifying runs, you will not receive an email.** However, results for all exhibitors are posted at the trial. Be sure to pick up your yellow scoresheet if you keep a record of all of your dog's results.

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after Closing

This trial is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing. A maximum number of entries will be placed on the wait list based on the entry limits as follows:

If trial is one ring/330- 350 runs, maximum will be 25 entries on the waitlist.

If the trial is 2 rings/660 - 700 runs, the maximum will be 50 dogs on the waitlist.

If the trial is 3 ring/ 990-1050 runs, the maximum will be 75 runs on the waitlist.

All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date. Any entries withdrawn that are received by the **Wednesday** ONE WEEK BEFORE the trial weekend @ 8 am will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry **minus a \$5 processing fee**. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by **Wednesday @ 8 am** ONE WEEK BEFORE the trial weekend will receive a refund.

If there is no waitlist, then there is no refund if you want to pull after the closing date.

If you have not heard about your Wait List status by Friday before the trial weekend, contact us ASAP.

MOVE-UPS

EMAILED MOVE-UPS: When emailing a move-up to us please give the following information:

TRIAL NAME, Owner's Name & Dog's Call Name
Move-up for what days (Friday, Saturday, Sunday, etc.)
Moving from (include STD, JWW or FAST)
Moving to (include STD, JWW or FAST)

Remember that you must send a **separate email** with the trial name in the subject line for **each trial move-up or cancellation**. Each trial is a separate database.

Emails sent to us regarding move-ups, cancellations, etc will be addressed on a priority basis. All correspondence will be processed within one week of receipt; however, those emails that pertain to the current trial will be processed before emails regarding trials that are scheduled for a later date.

We *always* send a reply email to all emailed cancellation requests when they are processed. We *always* send a reply email with a revised confirmation attached to all emailed move-up requests when they are processed.

If a response is NOT received before the above deadlines, please email it again and **also** send a backup fax request. We cannot accept move-up requests verbally. All move-up requests must be emailed, faxed, or mailed. Our Fax number and phone number are always in the premium. ISP SPAM filters can cause non-delivery of emails. Just because you sent an email to cancel or to move-up – that does not mean that we received. If you do not get a reply - then it means we never got it.

The move-up deadline is 6:00 p.m. the Monday prior to the trial weekend.

Cancellation and changes to classes, except move-ups, must be made before the **trial closing date and time (see premium for exact details)**. Please remember that Fast Times and the club are not responsible for emails that do not get delivered. We will not cancel an entry after the closing date and time or make a move-up after the move-up deadline due to non-delivery of an email *request!*

DAY-TO-DAY MOVE-UPS are for dogs entered at a set of back-to-back agility trials and must be submitted in writing at the trial within ½ hour after the last run of the trial day for the following day(s) and **cannot be conveyed via fax, email, or verbally to the trial secretary.**

NOVICE MOVE-UPS: Dogs or Handlers having attained ANY AKC Agility Title (Std, JWW, OR FAST class) **must be moved to the Nov B Classes** (Std, JWW and FAST classes).

PLEASE LET US KNOW AS SOON AS YOU REALIZE THAT A CHANGE IS NEEDED. Once we print all of the trial paperwork on Tuesday before the trial, it is a much bigger problem to fix. This request must be made in writing at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial. This request must state the reason and justification for the change from Novice A to Novice B. The dog can also be moved up a level (Nov to Open) at the request of the owner subject to the normal move-up criteria.

NOTES FROM TRIAL SECRETARY

1. Please remember to check the No Signature Required box AND sign that spot where you authorize them to deliver any overnight package. Our Post Office knows that we do not accept signature-required packages and they will not even attempt to deliver them. They just mark them "Refused" and return them to the sender. We never even know that you sent that package to us.
2. Remember that the Move-up Deadline for your first day of a weekend trial is **ALWAYS Monday at 6 pm prior to the trial weekend**. Please send those move-ups in right away.
3. Please review the section about Move-ups as we have added more clarification about requesting move-ups before and at the trials.
4. With all the paperwork we handle, mistakes are inevitable. We send out both Preliminary Confirmations and Final Confirmations. **PLEASE read these and double check that all the information is correct.** Having to change Gate boards, scribe sheets and computer records the day of the trial or the week of the trial is very difficult.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials only**. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program™** be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. COVID-19 Operating Guidelines

The Border Terrier Club of America organizers will work with state and local government and public health authorities prior to the start of the show to determine risks and mitigation factors. At this time, these are the advised guidelines. These guidelines may be revised as circumstances dictate.

On Site Process and Procedures

Border Terrier Club of America, Inc. shall require temperature monitoring for volunteers, officials, exhibitors, and service providers once daily prior to entering the event areas. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to enter the event areas. **Everyone entering show grounds will be required to wear a mask. Signage to this effect will be posted at the entrance and throughout the grounds.**

The following individuals will not be permitted on the show grounds:

- An individual who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms
- An individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 within last two weeks
- An individual who has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks.

Signage

The Border Terrier Club of America, Inc. will post signage that displays all applicable federal, state and local regulations, requirements and orders as well as WHO recommendations and CDC guidelines as they relate to mass gatherings and sporting events in effect at the show.

Signage will be posted at all entrances to the show grounds which identifies the symptoms of COVID-19 and states the following:

- To protect others from possible transmission of the virus, anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks (exception, healthcare personnel who have treated patients using appropriate medical-grade PPE during the course of performing professional duties), cannot enter the show grounds. These individuals are encouraged to contact their health care provider immediately for further medical advice and must obtain documented clearance from their health care provider before entering the show grounds. Participants must assume responsibility for themselves and their own staff (e.g. assistants, etc.).
- Recommendations about good hygiene along with informing participants and others about ways to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission.

Social distancing and limiting entries

- The Border Terrier Club of America, Inc. shall enforce social distancing requirements throughout the show grounds at all times.
- Prohibit the public and non-essential personnel from being on the show grounds. Non-participants may watch from outside the tent with proper distance between spectators but will not be allowed inside the tent.
- Organize dog and exhibitor arrivals and departures to limit contact between people, exhibitors must leave the tent immediately after showing and cannot return unless they have another dog to show or need to return to the ring with their dog.
- Arrange judges' and other officials' areas to comply with social distancing requirements.
- Restrict show officials and judges' areas access to essential personnel only. Limited entry will be considered if necessary. Regardless of the scope of the limitation, the limiting of entries must be done on a first come, first served basis and relevant information will be posted on the Show secretary's Website.

Enforcement Authority:

Stewards, Club Officials and AKC officials will inform individuals when they are not in compliance with the regulations and requirements in effect at the show and shall report such situations to the Club Officials and AKC. The Border Terrier Club of America has the authority to remove from the facility any person who does not comply with the regulations and requirements in effect.

If an individual needs an accommodation under the American Disabilities Act, request should be submitted, along with documentation of the disability and need for accommodation, to Nina Fetter, Executive Dog Shows. Requests for accommodations will be reviewed on a confidential basis with a medical consultant. Participants are required to comply with these and any additional Show Organizer requirements at all times while present on show grounds. Failure to do so may result in expulsion from the grounds. These requirements are in effect immediately and until further notice, however, they are subject to revisions as the COVID-19 environment changes.

Recommended Best Practices Covid-19

The following Recommended Best Practices have been provided to assist Show Organizers with determining risks and developing measures to mitigate those risks:

- Limit the number of entrances and exits to event areas to manage the number of individuals accessing event areas.
- Communication - Use radio, cell phone communication methods as much as possible and communicate important information frequently throughout the show grounds.

Ring Procedure

- All dogs enter on one side of the ring and exit on the other side
- Dogs will stand in the designated line, when the judge is examining the dog, the exhibitor and dog will move up to the next line and do their individual movement and return to the end of the line. The judge will point to the dog for its placement while standing in the lines (spaced 6 feet away from the other dogs) (**does not apply to agility**).
- Provide markers to delineate 6 feet spacing between people in any waiting lines.

Armbands Procedure (does not apply to agility)

- There will be tables set up by class to pick up armbands. Please allow for extra time to get your armband.
- Please do not gather around the tables.

Parking Considerations

- Parking area will be maintained completely separate from show area. RV parking is separate from regular auto parking.
- RV's will be parked no less than 15 feet apart. They will all be parked facing the same direction to ensure maximum separation of RV entrance/exits.
- Automobiles will be parked in a separate area and will be parked no less than 6 feet apart.

Considerations for Club Members, Medical Personnel, Service Providers & Volunteers

- Cleaning/Sanitizing Locations will be provided with access to soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer at several areas through the grounds.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided to all officials, ring crew, clean up and medical officials.
- There will be frequent cleaning and sanitizing of bathrooms. Soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer will be provided in bathrooms.
